OUR MISSION:

The 100 Club of Illinois provides resources, several forms of financial support, access to trainings and moral support to both the families of first responders killed in the line of duty and active duty first responders across Illinois. All sworn federal, state, county, and local first responders stationed in Illinois are included.

ASSISTANCE:

The 100 Club of Illinois is the longest standing first responder support organization in Illinois bringing hope to the survivors of tragic line of duty deaths of our everyday heroes. The Club Raises Hope for these families through investments in their livelihood, tuition for their educational goals, and resources to alleviate the stressors of life without their hero.



EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE

- Ensuring access to education for spouses and dependents of fallen first responders since 1970 by providing financial assistance to help cover tuition, fees, room and board, and other expenses related to higher education.
- \$9 million in support since 1970



LINE OF DUTY DEATH ASSISTANCE

- Investments in family resiliency
- Up to \$50,000 in immediate funds
- \$8 million in support since 1966

Since its inception in 1966, the 100 Club of Illinois has supported 400+ scholars in achieving their educational dreams. There are more than 120 children in the pipeline who will become eligible for assistance when they reach college age

MENTAL HEALTH:

The 100 Club of Illinois is the best positioned organization to provide resources for first responder resiliency and mental health, just as we have been providing the best support for their families for nearly 60 years. Armed with expert staff led training, a vibrant resource network of culturally competent professionals, and the ability to reach every first responder in the State of Illinois, the Club is fostering resiliency and tackling the mental health crisis within our first responder community.

When first responders are the ones in need of trauma response and incident triage, the Club responds.

WELLNESS & RESILIENCE TRAINING

We strive to provide a series of ongoing trainings covering a variety of topics including: Family Unit, New Hire, Peer Support, Resilience Development, and Department and Individual Wellness Initiatives. We are empowering first responders to take the initiative for safety and wellness to perform their duties at their best capacity.

FRONTLINE FUNDING

Our goal is to provide first responders with the health and wellness opportunities they need to be most effective on the job. We recognize that financial constraints may impact an individual or departments ability to do this as well as they otherwise could. Grant funds are available to individual first responders and departments.

CRITICAL INCIDENT RESPONSE

Our staff provides immediate consultation and multi-faceted response to critical incidents and line of duty deaths throughout the state. Our team can serve as a connection and referral point for treatment needs; line of duty death benefits and service coordination; and department support services.
